### Handicaps

On some of the event sign ups and on all National event sign ups you may have noticed a line for you to write your handicap? For a small charge you can get a GHIN handicap by joining at most of our

local golf courses or you can obtain one by joining the eClub Capital District. After you join, all you have to do is submit your scores for all your 18 hole rounds from any golf course you play. After you submit 5 scores, you will be issued an official handicap index. **We're urging all members who play golf on a regular basis each summer to get an official GHIN handicap this year.** If everyone had a GHIN handicap index, it would provide us with a better way to set up teams for our formal events so that the teams are more equal in ability. At least one of our formal events this year will offer participants who have an official GHIN handicap index the opportunity to play their own game instead of a scramble. (The scramble format will also be offered for everyone else.)

EClub Capital District is a New York State Golf Association "Type 3" or Internet club designed to provide golfers living within a 50 mile radius of Albany, NY with the benefits of a NYSGA/GHIN licensed golf club. With a membership fee of \$35, you will receive an official USGA Handicap Index as well as a membership into the New York State Golf Association. You will be able to enter all your golf scores online, as well as numerous statistics from each

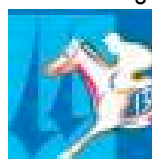
**1st tee time is 11am.** Plan on being there 1/2 hr. prior to your tee time. The format will be a scramble with longest drive and closest to pin competitions.

## Rules and More Rules

### Ball in bunker moved during search

Q. Hapless Larry managed to get in an-  
other golf predicament. Larry's soaring ball  
to the green landed short and buried itself  
in a bunker. The ball was completely cov-  
ered by sand. I mean the ball totally disap-  
peared. In searching for the ball, Larry's  
foot accidentally moved the ball and the  
ball became totally exposed, or in this  
case, uncovered.

What is the correct ruling/requirement?

- A. No penalty, however the ball must be  
replaced and totally covered with  
sand.
- B. No penalty, however the ball must be  
replaced and covered with sand but  
a part of the ball may be left visible.
- C. One stroke penalty and the ball must  
be replaced and totally covered with  
sand.
- D. One stroke penalty and the ball must  
be replaced and covered with sand  
but a part of the ball may be left visi-  
ble.

And the answer is...

The answer is B

There is no penalty; the ball must be re-  
placed and recovered so that only part of  
the ball is visible.

Rule 12-1 is applicable to this situation.  
In a hazard, if the ball is believed to be  
covered by sand or lose impediments, a  
player can remove by probing or raking  
with a club as much sand as needed so  
that he can see a part of the ball. If an ex-  
cess is removed, there is no penalty and  
the ball must be re-covered so that only a  
part of the ball is visible. If the ball is  
moved during the removal, there is no  
penalty; the ball must be replaced and, if  
necessary, re-covered.
